Short Side Trips in Nahan



Renuka Lake

Himachal's largest natural lake, surrounded by forests and myths. Perfect for boating, temple visits, and spotting wildlife at the nearby mini-zoo.

(Approx. 38 km, 1-1.5 hrs drive)

Paonta Sahib Gurudwara

Take a soulful excursion to the historic Gurudwara Ponta Sahib on the banks of River Yamuna.

(Approx. 41 km, 1 hrs drive)



Private Nature Escape

Take a peaceful walk through the property's private forest or stroll across the lush lawn to soak in the sunrise, sunset, and views of the charming town of Nahan

(Approx. 1-1.5 km , 30-40 mins walk)

Rani Tal

A serene pond built by the princes of Nahan, surrounded by temples and ancient structures. Perfect for quiet evening walks.

(Approx. 3 km, 8-10 min drive)



Suketi Fossil Park

India's first fossil park, with life-size fiberglass models of prehistoric animals. A fascinating stop for history buffs and families with kids.

(Approx. 20km , 50 minutes drive)



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
