

Savor a rustic outdoor picnic with curated baskets amidst towering deodars and crisp mountain breezes.






Gala Dinner

Browse shops, savor Himachali cuisine, and experience the lively colonial charm of Shimla's iconic Mall Road.






Forest Trails

Top things to do in Taraview







Tara Devi Temple

Perched atop a hill, this centuries-old temple dedicated to Goddess Tara offers serene vibes and panoramic views of the Himalayas.

(Approx. 24km, 1 hrs drive)

Shimla Toy Train

Board the Kalka–Shimla narrow–gauge railway, known for its scenic tunnels, bridges, and colonial charm. A must–do heritage experience.

(Approx. 6km, 20 minutes drive)









Kufri

A classic hill-station excursion with snow (in winter), adventure sports, horse rides, and Himalayan Nature Park.

(Approx. 15km, 50 minutes drive)

Chadwick Falls

A hidden gem surrounded by forests, best visited during monsoons for a refreshing nature escape.

(Approx. 11 km, 36 min drive)









Annandale Ground

A flat valley once used as a playground by the British. Now home to a Helipad, Army Heritage Museum, and lush pine surroundings.

(Approx. 9 km, 35 mins drive)
